Executive Summary: This circular provides guidance on the correct

use of wage types pertaining to additional hours

Each month the Shared Service Centre need to correct payroll data for Schools where incorrect wage types have been used when recording employee additional hours.

Why is this important?

Different wage types exist to ensure that employees are paid the correct rate of pay and in accordance with their Terms and Conditions of employment.

It is therefore vital that the correct wage type is used when recording additional hours as failure to do so could affect accrued leave entitlement and subsequent payment.

How can I ensure I use the correct wage type?

To help to clarify which wage type to use and prevent further wage type recording errors, a wage type flowchart has been produced.
