Transfer to Secondary Education - September 2025

During the week commencing 2 September 2024 you will receive a supply of leaflets relating to the secondary transfer process.

I would be grateful if you will ensure that all Year 6 Derbyshire children without an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP) are provided with a copy of the leaflet to take to their parent/guardian. As in recent years we no longer send individual letters to all parents.

The leaflet summarises the application process and encourages them to make their application online. Applications open on 9 September 2024.

We prefer parents to apply online through the [Admissions area of the Derbyshire County Council website](#). It would be appreciated if you would publicise this facility and strongly encourage parents to make their application online. Please note that the telephone service previously provided by Call Derbyshire is no longer available. Parents without access to the internet should contact the Admissions and Transport Team by ringing 01629 537499 for advice on how to make an application.

Parents requiring a hard copy of the guide should contact the Admissions and Transport Team - details as above.

Parents of children with an EHCP are advised that the transfer of their child is dealt with via the annual review, and they will receive information direct from the SEND Team.

With regard to out of county children, we have requested that the home authority forward appropriate transfer information. However, you will also be sent individual letters for these children advising parents to contact their home authority direct.

The leaflets must be issued to parents via the children during the week ending **Friday 6 September 2024**, together with the appropriate secondary school booklet, which you should have received direct from the school. If a Year 6 child is absent from school on Friday 6 September 2024, I would be grateful if you will post a leaflet to the parent's home. **The closing date for the submission of applications is midnight on Thursday 31 October 2024.**

You will be able to see the applications for your year 6 children as they are entered on the Admissions System by choosing the leavers option on the Schools Access Module (SAM).
