This information sheet is to raise awareness of NHS community pharmacy services available.

Community pharmacies can see people regarding a range of conditions. Detail on these services is below;

• **Minor illnesses**; such as coughs, colds, sore throat, bites or stings, athletes foot, skin rash, blisters, constipation, diarrhoea, scabies, nasal congestion, earache, mouth ulcers, wounds, vaginal itch, headache and allergic reactions.

• Seven Common Conditions;

Ear infection 1 to 17 years

Impetigo 1 year and over

Infected insect bites 1 year and over

Shingles 18 years and over

Sinusitis 12 years and over

Sore throat 5 years and over

Uncomplicated urinary tract infections Women 16-64 years

- Oral Contraception; you can obtain supplies of the contraceptive
 pill from a community pharmacy without the need for a prescription.
 Community Pharmacy Pharmacists can have a free consultation with
 anyone who would like to start on oral contraception or get a repeat
 supply of their oral contraception.
- Blood Pressure Checks are available in community pharmacies, for people aged 40 or over who have not got a diagnosis of hypertension and have not had a blood pressure check by a healthcare professional in the last six months.
