Do you <b>ensure</b> that staff have sufficient understanding and use of English to ensure the well-being of children in your care?	How do you check employees have sufficient understanding and use of English to ensure the well-being of children? What information and, or evidence do you require to check this?
<ul> <li>Do you ensure you are able to:</li> <li>keep records in English?</li> <li>liaise with other agencies in English?</li> <li>summon emergency help?</li> <li>understand instructions such as those for the safety of medicines or food hygiene?</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>How do you ensure that your assistants have sufficient understanding and use of English for their role and responsibilities?</li> <li>What other situations require a certain level of comprehension and ability to speak English?</li> </ul>
