Do you <b>ensure</b> you have access to an outdoor play area?  If this is not possible, do you <b>ensure</b> that outdoor activities planned and taken on a daily basis (unless circumstances make this inappropriate, for example <b>unsafe</b> weather conditions)?	<ul> <li>How do all children, including babies, have access to an outdoor play space?</li> <li>How can you be sure these outdoors spaces are accessed every day?</li> <li>If you do not have an appropriate outdoor area, how do you ensure all children still access quality outdoor experiences every day?</li> </ul>
Do you <b>ensure</b> you follow your legal responsibilities under the Equality Act 2010 (for example, the provisions on reasonable adjustments)?	<ul> <li>What are your legal responsibilities are under the Equality Act 2010? How do you ensure you meet them?</li> <li>If you do not own your premises, how do you work with the owner to ensure legal responsibilities are met?</li> <li>Have you made reasonable adjustments to make your setting inclusive for all children? What adjustments have you made? What future adjustment might you need to make?</li> </ul>
