

## RSE Portal update



The [RSE Portal](#) has been commissioned by Derbyshire Public Health to support schools in developing their Relationships and Sex Education (RSE).

It provides three surveys

- a [‘baseline and progress survey’](#) for **RSE Leads only** to take a snapshot of current position
- A [staff confidence survey](#) to measure staff confidence and identify training needs - share this link directly with staff.
- A [children and young people’s survey](#) to ensure RSE is meeting pupil need.

The results from the surveys can be viewed on your school’s online dashboard to help you to easily access them and identify areas for development or capture progress.

Results of the surveys are collated and displayed on your school’s dashboard.

### **Why do the surveys?** Schools can use the results to

- identify levels of staff confidence in teaching RSE and training needs
- raise the profile of RSE with governors and school leaders
- gain confidential pupil views on the RSE they are receiving
- measure their annual progress in RSE development
- compare their results with the Derbyshire average as a benchmark.

**The Portal will be available until end of Dec 2023. Please use the surveys this term if you would like to compare this year’s results with next year’s.**
